

POLICY FOR THE ISSUE OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY CREATED/PRODUCED BY STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITY MALAYA

Terms of the policy of the Intellectual Property Publications produced by the University Students:-

1. Apart from post-graduate students, degree based students are also required to sign the policy recommendations on the delivery of HI in their work to the University. However, this requirement is limited to only final year students for the purpose of protecting the HI resulting from scientific projects at the end of their research.
2. Authority to grant permission to any graduate student (final year) degree program or students who wish to publish their HI as a book is given to the Head of their faculties.
3. Authority to grant permission to any student of doctoral degree programs who wish to publish their HI which they have produced as a book is given to the Dean of the Institute of Graduate Studies (IPS).
4. Application and authorization for the purpose of publishing HI should be made in writing.
5. Students who wish to publish their HI as a book is required to make a statement that the published work is generated from the project / thesis / dissertation that they provide to the University in their programs.
6. Use of the University logo in the publication concerned is not allowed unless granted specific permission for that purpose.
7. Granted permissions are only applicable to publications mentioned in the application of students only. Students may not use the granted permission other than the purpose stated in the application.
8. If necessary and agreed upon by the parties involved, payment of royalties to the following ratio:

Creator/Designer 75%: University 25%
